The key principles of the design are how it integrates into the landscape and adopts the forest school principles. Natural cedar cladding has been used for the façade along timber shingles for the roof of the two classrooms. The class bases have been towards views towards the landscape with access to outdoor play space with a covered canopy to provide shade. The building is single storey and fits into the existing landscape. Seven number class bases are provided along with art and practical food rooms. The two class wings are formed around the central hall which is the shared dining and sports spaces
